

END -OF-THE-YEAR REPORT (2016)
MEATLOAF MINISTRY

As the result of efforts by volunteers of the meatloaf ministry, I am happy to let you know that during the calendar year 2016, 132 meatloaves were baked and delivered to the House of Bread in Hartford and used in meals for the homeless. That number of meatloaves resulted in about 800 meals for the homeless served in dinner entrees, sandwiches and/or additional protein for breakfasts. Our numbers dropped again this past year, and meatloaves were collected during 11 of the months--with no collection in August.

I thank all of you who have cooperated in this ministry, and I especially appreciate the help of John Griffin who picks up the meatloaves and delivers them to the House of Bread in Hartford, and whose wife, Debbie, also bakes meatloaves. I also appreciate the generosity of those who spontaneously donate a meatloaf without being called.
