

END -OF-THE-YEAR REPORT (2015)
MEATLOAF MINISTRY

As the result of efforts by volunteers of the meatloaf ministry, I am happy to let you know that during the calendar year 2015, 139 meatloaves were baked and delivered to the House of Bread in Hartford and used in meals for the homeless. That number of meatloaves resulted in about 835 meals for the homeless served in dinner entrees, sandwiches and/or additional protein for breakfasts. Our numbers dropped a little this past year, and we still came through with meatloaves all 12 months of the year.

I thank all of you who have cooperated in this ministry, and I especially appreciate the help of John Griffin who picks up the meatloaves and delivers them to the House of Bread in Hartford, and whose wife, Debbie, also bakes meatloaves.
